# RAIN RUINS ANOTHER DAY

With rain drenching the area over the last two days, the entire 15-game high school baseball schedule for *The Trentonian's* area was washed out yesterday.

While most teams are hoping their fields will get a chance to dry out today, two games were rescheduled for today.

West Windsor-Plainsboro will try to play Princeton at Valley Road Field at 4 p.m. Hightstown will visit Lawrence at Eggerts Crossing Park at 7 p.m.

Most teams decided to wait the extra day.

Peddle's home game with Hill, Northern Burlington's home game with Burlington Township, Morrisville's home game with Devon Prep and Delran's Burlington County Scholastic League Tournament game with Cinnaminson were all moved to tomorrow afternoon.

The Lawrenceville School will shoot to play its game at the Hun School at 4:15 p.m. Thursday, while Allentown will host Robbinsville at 4 p.m. Friday in place of its regularly-

scheduled, non-league game with Keyport.

Princeton Day School will head to the Pennington School next Monday for a 4:15 p.m. clash.

Ewing's game at Nottingham has been moved to 4 p.m. Tuesday, May 19.

With the rain threatening to stick around for a while, five teams could not figure out where to put their makeup games.

Steinert's showdown at Notre Dame, Hopewell Valley's game at Hamilton, Trenton's game at West Windsor-Plainsboro North, Borden town's game at Westampton Tech and Trenton Catholic Academy's game with Emily Fisher Charter, which was to be played at Waterfront Park, were all postponed indefinitely.
