

# Trenton Catholic pulls off first win since 2007

**WESTAMPTON** — They may have gotten a little help from the rain, but they don't care.

All the people at Trenton Catholic Academy care about today is that their varsity baseball team was able to end its 43-game losing streak by defeating Westampton Tech, 7-6, in five innings because of rain.

It was the Iron Mike's first win since May 18, 2007. Ironically, that 12-7 victory also happened at Westampton.
