Steinert, the defending Mercer County Tournament champion, secured the No. 1 seed in the 31st annual county tournament, which is set to get underway May 8.

The Spartans (15-2) will look to bring home their 16th MCT title in school history and sixth under head coach Brian Giallella.

Robbinsville (13-2), which has won seven straight and 12 of its last 13 games, drew the No. 2 seed, while Notre Dame (10-3), which has appeared in three of the last four finals, was tabbed as the No. 3 seed. Princeton Day School (10-5) rounded out the top four.
